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Subject:-Tour Note Handwara- Ramhal.

District Development Commissioner Kupwara along with various officers of the District visited Handwara-Ramhal area on 10/07/2018 and took the stock of the important developmental works and other official activities as well as essential public services. During the inspection the following directions were passed.

1. **PHC Natnussa:** It was observed that footfall at the PHC is relatively low. Further, robustness and was not visible at the Centre as far delivery of services is concerned. There was too little activity visible about ant-natal care and post natal care. Labour room, lab facility, etc are not being utilized optimally. The health activities under the Aspirational District Programme with regard to the specific indicators are not being carried out regularly. CMO Kupwara will direct the BMO concerned to give greater attention to field activities and personally monitor the functioning of PHC Natnussa with special focus on indicators, outcomes, etc. He will furnish action taken report within ten days.
2. **Govt HSS Batpora:** It was observed that academic and extra-curricular activities need to be carried out in a more planned and organized manner. The Principal shall frequently organize debates, quizzes, seminars, etc in the school to improve the general knowledge of the students and build their personality. Sports activities need to be taken up in a more organized manner. CEO Kupwara shall examine the possibility of shifting the lower classes to the nearby Middle School in the interest of imparting better education to the students.
3. **Govt HSS Vilgam:** The principal shall ensure availability of teaching staff in the school. Academic activity needs to be carried out with focus and preparation. Due



attention needs to be paid to extra-curricular activities like debates, quizzes, seminar, sports, etc.

PHC Vilgam: The working of PHC Vilgam needs to be improved on immediate basis. CMO Kupwara shall personally monitor the functioning of PHC Vilgam and ensure delivery of health services in a desired manner. All activities relating to ante-natal and post natal care need to be carried out in a robust manner. Special camps for the benefit of pregnant and nursing women, newborn babies, infants, adolescent girls, school going children, etc be organized on a mass scale in the block by the BMO concerned under the direct supervision of the CMO. CMO shall also explore the possibility of providing additional manpower to the PHC keeping in view the patient load and catchment area of the institution. Further, Executive Engineer R&B shall furnish realistic estimates for renovation of the old/gutted block of the PHC in three days positively.

5. **PMGSY Road Manzgam:** The Executive Engineer PMGSY shall in consultation with the revenue authorities and the local population, take steps for attaining maximum width as prescribed in the norms and subject to feasibility on ground and furnish action taken report within 10 days.
